


Left Mittens



Print, laminate and cut out. Have your child either clip a clothespin to the correct number or use a dry erase marker to circle the correct number.



Print, laminate and cut out the cards. Have your child clip a clothespin to the correct number or use a dry erase marker to circle the correct number. I punch a hole in the top left corner of the cards and put them on a jump ring {after mixing up the card numbers} so that they are not in numerical order. You can also make them into a small counting booklet and/or have your child point out the animals that are missing from the mitten.

Directional Words and Word Recognition

Print out the following pages {a mini-reader of sorts}.

Cut each sheet of paper in half and then staple the pages together. Cut out the clip art below and have your child glue the appropriate pieces to the story pages. Use the vocabulary word sheet to help your child identify some of the words in the story if needed.







The mitten is **under** the tree.




The mitten is **next to** Nicki.

The mitten is in front of the bear.











The mitten is **between** the fox and the mole.




